Governing Equation

$$\frac{\partial T}{\partial t} = \alpha \frac{\partial^2 T}{\partial x^2}$$

RELATIVE IMPORTANCE OF INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL RESISTANCE TO HEAT TRANSFER

Biot Number

$$N_{Bi} = \frac{hD}{k}$$

Negligible internal resistance $N_{Bi} <$

Negligible surface resistance $N_{Bi} >$

Finite internal and surface resistance $<N_{Bi}<$

NEGLECTIBLE INTERNAL RESISTANCE TO HEAT TRANSFER

$$\ln(T_a - T) = \frac{hAt}{\rho c_p V}$$

NEGLECTIBLE SURFACE RESISTANCE TO HEAT TRANSFER

Fourier Number

$$\frac{\text{Rate of heat conduction across D in volume } D^3 \text{ (W/C)}}{\text{Rate of heat storage in volume } D^3 \text{ (W/C)}}$$

Large value of N_{Fo} indicates deeper penetration of heat into solid in a given period of time.
